There has been other issues, there has been other people locally who had issues with the same results. Other in the community have caught him lying about how he votes or doesn't vote.

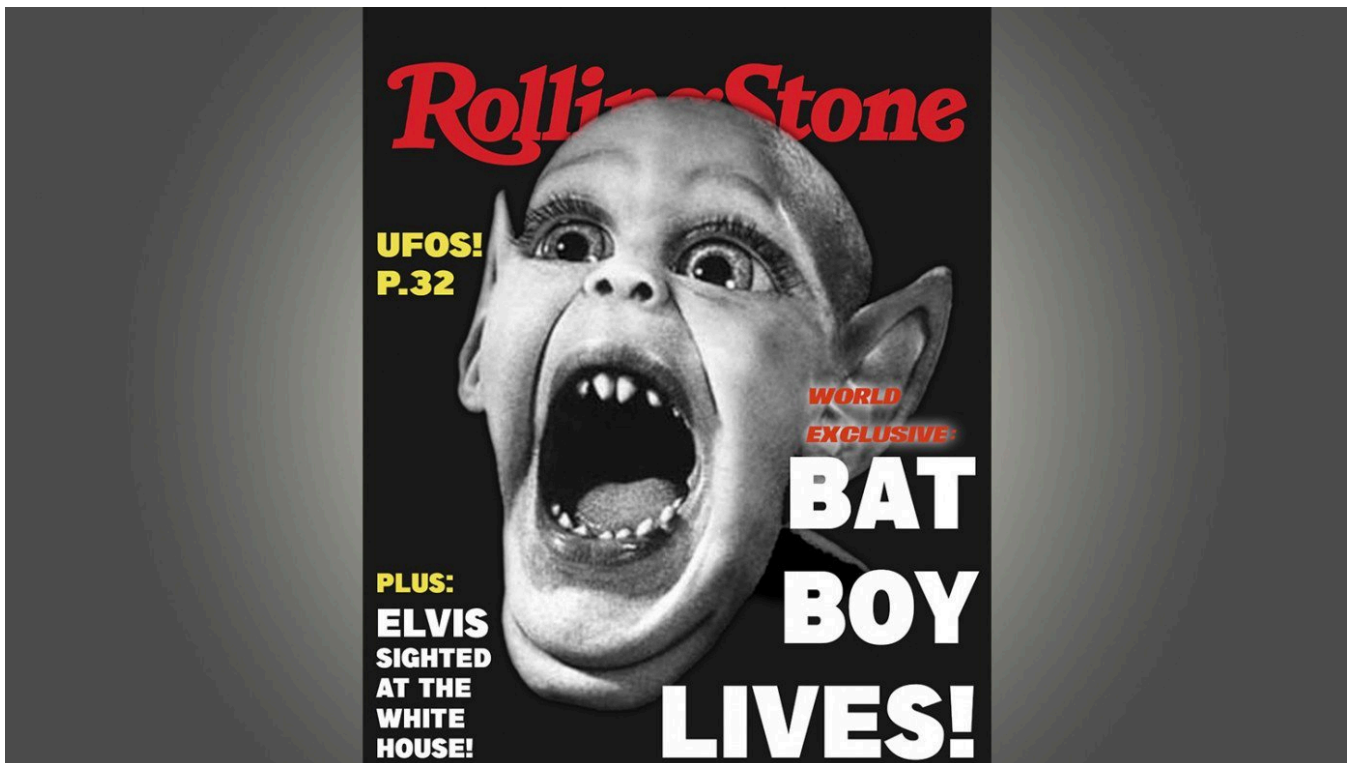
I have total disgust and distain for this individual now. He's supposed to be our representative, our employee....like many political figures who get elected they forget what their job is and who they work for.

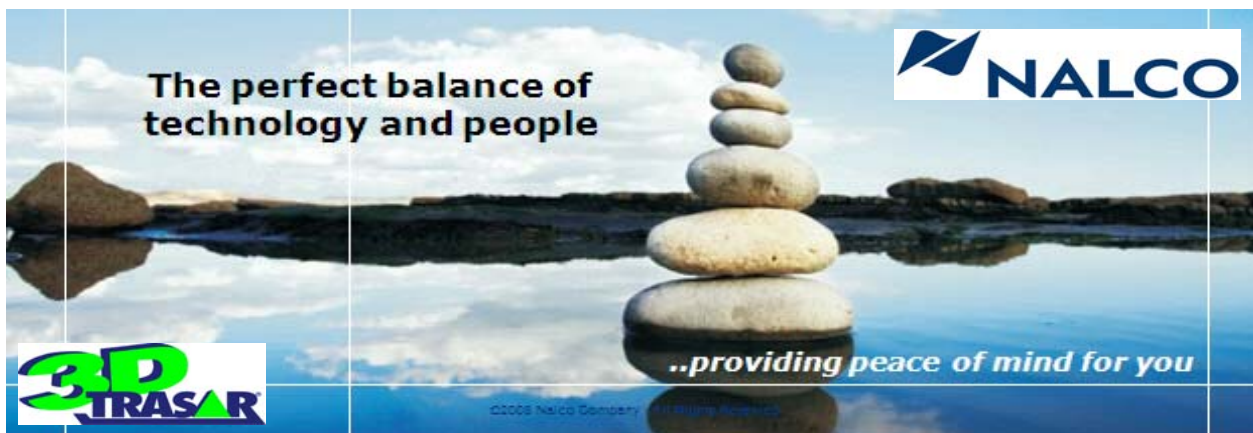
